### **Day 1 Winnipeg, MB**

### **Day 3 Winnipeg, MB**

### **special exhibit "Journey to Churchill."**

This exhibit is dedicated to the subarctic terrain, wildlife, and culture of Churchill, Manitoba, the Polar Bear Capital of the World. The 10-acre exhibit includes polar bears, muskoxen, wolves, and other northern species. We'll be guided through five distinct areas of the exhibit, The Wapusk Lowlands, Gateway To The Arctic, Aurora Borealis Theater, Churchill Coast & Leatherdale International Polar Bear Conservation Centre. Once you have finished with this, there will be time to visit other parts of the zoo also. We'll have lunch on your own and some free time to explore **The Forks**, a historic and unique shopping area with many restaurants. Next we will visit the **Canadian Museum for Human Rights**. While strolling the museum you will encounter thousands of stories featuring people, events and ideas from all over the world. From the breathtaking architecture, to the moving stories and captivating exhibitions and programs, every part of the Museum offers a unique encounter. Tonight, we'll head back to the **Folklorama** and enjoy **3 more Pavillions!** (B, D)
