Day 1 Fish Creek, WI

We depart this morning on a fantastic fall adventure in Wisconsin traveling to Fish Creek to check-in to our hotel. Tonight, enjoy a delicious **included dinner** at a local favorite! (D)

Day 2 Fish Creek, WI

Our **local guide** will join us today and show us around **Door County**, located on the peninsula between Green Bay and Lake Michigan. Our guide will show us the cultural, natural and maritime history of Door County. Our day of touring begins with a lakeside drive featuring a visitor to a historic Door County Lighthouse, **Bailey's Harbor Range Lights**. Morning stops also include a **guided tour of Boynton Chapel** and a **beach walk** near the **Ridges Sanctuary**. These lakeside areas contrast the bayside's steep topography. After an **included lunch** at the famous **Al Johnson's Swedish Restaurant** (where goats graze the roof) we'll drive through **Peninsula State Park** on the Niagara Escarpment, providing grand water views overlooking the Bay of Green Bay. We'll also visit and explore an authentic **pioneer cemetery**, located within the Park's boundaries and hear about some of the County's early inhabitants, then stop at a **local farm market and winery** to feast on fresh apples and some wine. We complete our day with a **traditional Door County Fish Boil** for dinner (fish alternatives available). (B, L, D)

Day 3 Black River Falls, WI

Today we will attend the **48th annual Warrens Cranberry Festival**. We'll pick up our guide and do a **tour of the Cranberry Marsh**. Our tour gives us an up close look at a cranberry bed

to see how cranberries grow and the equipment used to harvest cranberries. Known for three miles of shopping, the festival boasts over 800 arts and crafts booths, 350 flea market and antique booths, 100 farms market booths and 100 food vendors. You'll have plenty of time to walk around and enjoy this shoppers paradise. We will overnight in Black River Falls, WI. (B)

Day 4 Home

We begin our day at **Cabin Ridge** in Cadott, Wisconsin. Here, a carriage will take us through the autumn woods to a lodge where we'll enjoy a **yummy included lunch**. Then we'll board our carriage back to the bus and be on our way back home. (B, L)
