

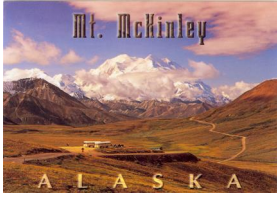
**Wednesday, August 13**

**Fairbanks, Alaska**

We will board a narrow gauge railway car that will take us to the **Little Eldorado Gold Camp**, seeing the many ways of finding gold, and then doing some panning for ourselves. After a stop at the Pipeline we will board the **Discovery Riverboat** and cruise the Chena and Tanana Rivers. We'll explore the Eskimo cultures and see dog sled demonstrations.

**Thursday, August 14**

**Denali, Alaska**



Before departing Fairbanks this morning, we will visit the **University of Alaska Museum**. Traveling south today we enter into **Denali National Park**. We will check into our lodging this afternoon, and then enjoy a

guided **wildlife** tour of Denali National Park on one of their special buses. We will learn the history of the park as well as keep a look out for moose, caribou, and bear.

**Friday, August 15**

**Anchorage, Alaska**

As we travel South today our first stop will be at the **Veteran's Memorial** for one more chance to see Mt. McKinley and then we'll visit **Iditarod** Headquarters in Wasilla. Upon arrival to Anchorage, we will do a city tour and then we check into our hotel accommodations for the next two nights.

After our included breakfast this morning we will travel along Turn-Again Arm today to Whittier and board a boat for our **26 Glacier Cruise**



along Prince William Sound. This highlight will enlighten us with many glaciers and icebergs. (B,LD)

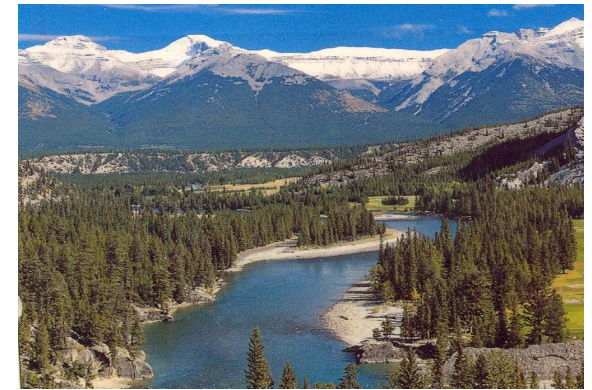

**Saturday, August 2** **Minot, North Dakota**  
Join us as we celebrate 17 years of traveling North to Alaska. We begin our journey by traveling through Minnesota to North Dakota, getting acquainted with fellow travelers. Our overnight lodging will be in the Magic City of Minot. (L)

**Sunday, August 3** **Medicine Hat, Alberta**  
We leave the United States this morning and enter our neighboring country of Canada. The first province we will travel through will be Saskatchewan, the breadbasket of Canada, where 60% of Canada's wheat is grown. Our lodging this evening will be in Medicine Hat. (B)

**Monday, August 4** **Banff, Alberta**  
Today we will enter our second province, Majestic Alberta. We will arrive in Calgary, the Gateway to the Rocky Mountains and the home of the 1988 Winter Olympics, touring the **Olympic Park**. Next, we are off to Banff, a town surrounded by a stunning mountain landscape. Our overnight accommodations tonight are in Banff. (B)



**Tuesday, August 5** **Jasper, Alberta**  
We travel through **Banff National Park** and into **Jasper National Park** today. Some of the scenic stops today will be Peyto Lake, and the famous Lake Louise, and its emerald green water. This afternoon, we'll see the largest body of ice south of the Arctic Circle, Columbia Icefield. Our lodging this evening is in the town of Jasper.

**Wednesday, August 6** **Smithers, Alberta**  
We'll visit Maligne Canyon this morning after departing Jasper. You will notice a change in the scenery as we travel to the third province of British Columbia, making a stop at the visitor center, with an excellent view of Mt. Robson. We travel as far as Smithers for the evening.

**Thursday, August 7** **Ferry**  
We will be driving along the scenic rivers most of the day. Our journey will take us to Prince Rupert, British Columbia. We board the **Alaska Marine Highway Ferry** late this afternoon. While traveling along the Inside Passage, watch for whales, dolphins, and other sea life. A naturalist will be on board giving narration on many topics we will see along the Inside Passage. Our overnight accommodations will be in berths on the ferry. Onboard there is a cafeteria, gift shop, theatre, and much more to enjoy while ferrying the Inside Passage.



**Friday, August 8** **Juneau, Alaska**  
Our day will be spent touring Juneau. We will start with a visit to **Mendenhall Glacier**, located 12 miles from downtown Juneau. We will make a brief stop at the **University of Alaska grounds** for a spectacular view overlooking Mendenhall Glacier. Then we will visit the **Alaska State Museum**, a collection of Alaska's history since 1900, home to more than 23,000 artifacts and works of art. There will be time this afternoon for you to browse on your own.

**Saturday, August 8** **Skagway, Alaska**  
We will board the Alaska Marine Highway today to ferry through the Lynn Canal enroute to Skagway. We will overnight in Skagway.

**Sunday, August 10** **Whitehorse, Yukon**  
We board the **White Pass and Yukon Route train** and head up over the White Pass with its gorgeous canyons, waterfalls, and snow-capped mountains. A short stop will be made at Carcross and then on into Miles Canyon on the Yukon River. Upon arrival to Whitehorse, we will make short stop at the **S.S. Klondike** as well as see the fish ladder, Old Log Church, Log Cabin Sky-scapers and other interesting sights. Our entertainment tonight will be a rousing good time at the **Frantic Follies**.

**Monday, August 11** **Tok, Alaska**  
The entire day will be spent traveling along the Alaska Highway. The highway has been greatly improved in the past several years, originally being built in 1949. We will make stops to view the original bridges and see the authentic trappers cabins. We'll drive as far as Tok, the "dog sled capital of the world." (L)

**Tuesday, August 12** **Fairbanks, Alaska**  
Again we will travel along the Alaska Highway to its final mile in Delta Junction. Our lunch will be included at Rika's Roadhouse. Upon leaving, Rika's Roadhouse we will get our first glimpse of the Alaska pipeline as it crosses the Tenana River. Next, we stop at the "**North Pole**", and allow some time to shop at the Santa Claus House before reaching our hotel for the next two evenings in Fairbanks. Tonight, we will be treated to an all-you-can-eat **Salmon Bake**, with salmon, ribs and cod. (L, D)
